




Why did we need Volunteers for the World Cup?

- People want to help and be part of something bigger









- Long-Term Volunteers helped immensely in scaling the process








International Volunteers





- Prioritise the Volunteer Experience

- Smile, laugh and enjoy yourself ٠









- Included a mini trophy, pen and Unilever care pack


