- Find new ways to work with limited resources

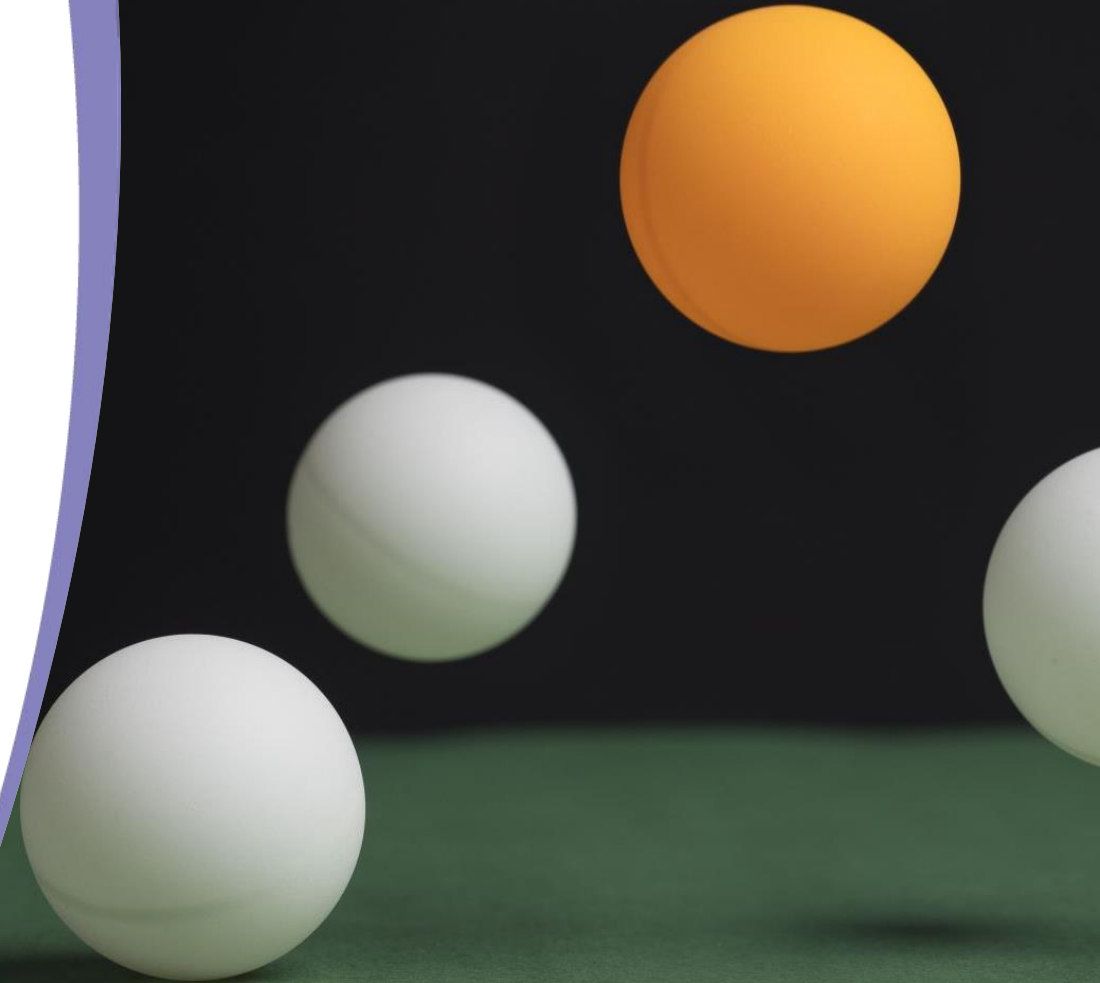
Embrace risk and accidental success
