By gaining 16 CPD points in 2021/22, you will receive the letters **PLV** which can be highlighted after your name as an achievement of completion. This post-nominal will help raise your profile, and demonstrates your commitment to your career, and to the volunteer leadership profession.

- Achieve 16 CPD points by the end of June 2021 to receive your formal certificate awarding your right to have PLV after your name
- Be inspired to gain more knowledge and upskill yourself
- Promote your point of difference to current and future employers
- Be recognised for the learning you're already doing/planning

- Writing a reflective piece on your volunteering leadership over the CPD year

4. Update your activity validation form and send to VWA every two months or at the end of June 2022.
5. Achieve 16 CPD points by the end of June 2022 and receive your formal certificate and option to use **PLV** after your name.
