- Represent Volunteering WA and volunteering sector on committees
- Prepare VWA's annual state budget submission and other relevant submissions
- Prepare pre-election priorities on consultation with members and stakeholders
- Support the advocacy work of the CEO and other stakeholders
- Provide input into national policy submissions
- Establish and maintain relationships with relevant partners and collaborators to facilitate strategic stakeholder engagement
