Volunteering WA's Continuous Professional Development Program (CPD) for Professional Leaders of Volunteers (PLV) is a formal avenue to improve your knowledge and skills to raise the standard of volunteer leadership in your organisation and across WA.

BENEFITS OF PARTICIPATING

- Be inspired to gain more knowledge and upskill yourself.
- Promote your point of difference to current and future employers.
- Be recognised for the learning you're already doing/planning.
- Achieve 16 CPD points withing 12 months of your start date to receive your formal certificate awarding your right to have PLV after your name.

By gaining 16 CPD points, you will receive the letters PLV which can be highlighted after your name as an achievement of completion.

This post-nominal will help raise your profile, and demonstrates your commitment to your career, and to the volunteer leadership profession.

ATTAINING CPD POINTS

Participants are expected to accumulate a minimum of 16 points within 12 months of commencing the program, through a combination of:

- Professional development, events and services offered by VWA.
- Professional development at your organisation.
- Reading relevant industry articles.
- Mentoring colleagues/members in volunteering management.
- Writing a reflective piece on your volunteering leadership over the CPD year.

GET STARTED

- 1. Apply online CPD Application Form
- Read the FAQs and CPD Activity Point Schedule to plan your CPD activities for the year - you must achieve minimum 16 points.
- Participate in your chosen CPD activities and complete the Activity Validation Form after each activity.
- Update your activity validation form and send to training@volunteeringwa.org.au every quarter.
- Achieve 16 CPD points within 12 months and receive your formal certificate and option to use PLV after your name.
